#### **Socially Responsible Investing (SRI) : Why it Matters? How to Get Involved?**

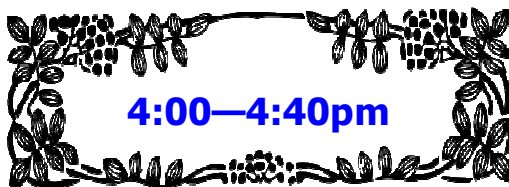
